Help is available for Humboldt County residents to make their homes and families safer in the event of wildfire!

This is a “first-come, first-served” program and funding is limited. APPLY TODAY!

The FLASH Program helps landowners comply with state defensible space requirements to maintain a 100 foot “Lean, Clean and Green Zone” around their home.

Financial assistance of \$100 to \$650 per acre, up to a total of \$3,000 per property owner, is available to local landowners and residents as a rebate when they complete fuels reduction projects around homes, along roads, and other high priority areas.

Information and a free wildfire hazard risk assessment will be provided by your local FLASH representative!

Funding provided by the Cooperative Fire Program of the U.S. Forest Service, Department of Agriculture, Pacific Southwest Region, through the California Fire Safe Council. Coordination and support provided by the Humboldt County Fire Safe Council, the County of Humboldt, CAL FIRE, and UC Cooperative Extension.
