

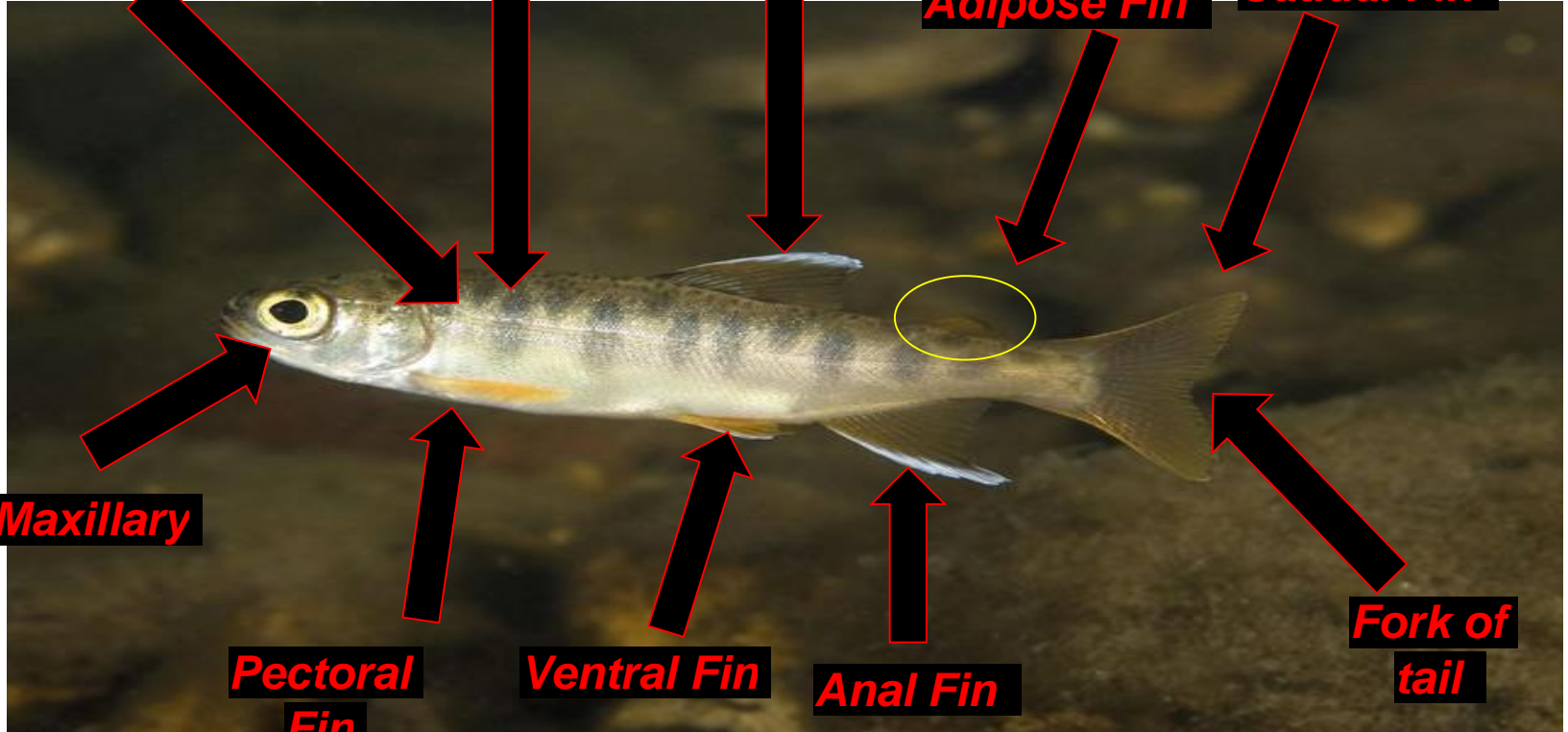
Lateral Line

Juvenile

Juvenile Coho Salmon

- There are no spots on fins
- White and sometime black flagging on anal and dorsal fins
- First two anal fin rays are longer than the rest, that's where the sickle shape comes from
- Eyes look large compared to its body
- Has a strongly forked tail
- Parr marks narrower or longer and higher than the space between them



Juvenile chinook

Juvenile Chinook

- Parr marks are darker above lateral line (this line that runs on the side of the fish)
- Parr marks are wider than the space between them
- Parr marks appear bigger than eye
- 13-19 anal fin rays



Juvenile Steelhead

Juvenile Steelhead

- Dorsal fin has spots
- Black outline on its adipose fin
- Has a red stripe along its side or lateral line
- Bluntly forked tail
- Often have orange tinted fins as juveniles round and evenly spaced parr marks connected on lateral line

Definitions

Parr Marks: The marking on the side and fins of fish

Lateral Line: The line that runs along the side of the fish

Bluntly: dull

Maxillary: An attachment to the jaw or jaw bone, mainly the upper jaw
